Terms and Conditions

The Pulse SMHF Staff Lottery provides staff with an opportunity to support projects that enhance patient care, staff wellbeing, research, innovation, education and community health outcomes, while also having the chance to win a prize.

Purpose

The Pulse South Metro Health Foundation Staff Lottery is conducted to raise funds in support of initiatives that enhance healthcare experiences and outcomes across South Metropolitan Health Service.

Net proceeds will be applied only for the purpose approved under the lottery permit.

Lottery Period

The lottery opens at 9:00am on 4th September 2026 and closes at 5:00pm AWST on 2nd October 2026.

Entries received after the closing date and time will not be eligible for inclusion in the draw.

Eligibility

Entry is open **ONLY** to:

- Current employees of South Metropolitan Health Service (SMHS), who are Australian residents aged 18 years or over.
- Individuals who complete the required registration process.
- Individuals who provide a valid Australian bank account in their own legal name for direct debit payments.
- Individuals who successfully purchase one or more tickets during the lottery period.

The following persons are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to enter:

- Directors and employees of Pulse.
- Immediate family members of Pulse directors and employees.
- Persons directly involved in administering or conducting the lottery.

Conditions of Entry and Payment

- Entry is available via direct debit payment only.
- Payroll deductions are not accepted.
- Each ticket costs \$5.00.
- Each ticket purchased constitutes one entry into the draw.
- Participants may purchase multiple tickets.
- Tickets will only be entered into the draw once full payment has been successfully received and cleared.
- All eligible paid entries will be included in the draw.
- Tickets are non-transferable once issued.

Lottery Draw

- The draw will take place on 5th October 2026 at Fiona Stanley Hospital Admin Building.

- The draw will be conducted fairly and in accordance with the conditions of Standard Lottery Permit LS225288226.
- The winning ticket will be selected through a random draw process.
- Each valid ticket has an equal chance of winning.
- All sold tickets will be included in the draw.

Notification of the Winner and Publication

The winner will be notified via telephone and/or email using the contact details provided during registration.

Results will be published on 7th October 2026.

The winner may be required to verify their identity before prize payment.

The prize will be paid via direct deposit within 30 days of the draw date.

Celebrating Our Winner

By entering the lottery, participants acknowledge that Pulse may publish the winner's first name, surname initial and work location for the purpose of announcing lottery results and celebrating the impact of staff support.

Publication may occur through SMHS and Foundation communications, websites, newsletters, staff communications and other approved channels, subject to applicable privacy requirements.

Refunds and Cancellation

Refund requests must be submitted in writing to hello@pulsefoundation.com.au.

Once a ticket has been generated and entered into the draw, refunds will not be provided unless approved in writing by the Gaming and Wagering Commission.

The lottery cannot be cancelled after ticket sales have commenced without written approval from the Gaming and Wagering Commission.

Any approved refund will be returned via the original payment method where practicable.

No refunds will be issued for entries already included in a completed draw.

Privacy

Pulse collects personal information, including names, contact details and payment information, for the purpose of administering the lottery.

Personal information may also be used to provide information about Foundation activities, fundraising initiatives and community impact unless participants choose to opt out.

Personal information will be stored securely and accessed only by authorised personnel.

Personal information will be managed in accordance with applicable privacy legislation.

Pulse reserves the right to declare an entry invalid where:

- The entrant does not meet the eligibility requirements.
- Payment has not been successfully received.
- False, misleading or incomplete information has been supplied.

Invalid entries may be excluded from the draw.

Unclaimed Prizes
